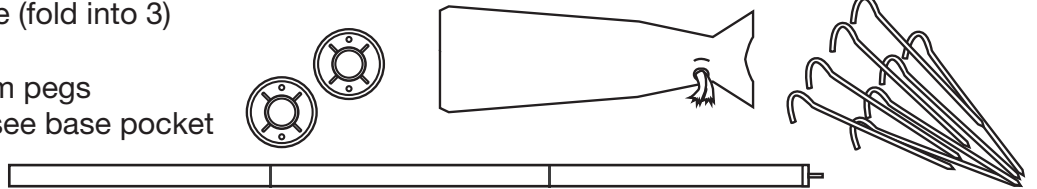


## EXPANSE Backpack Bed®

### ACCESSORIES INCLUDED

- 2 x Pole holders - use your poles on sand and mud without sinking / moving
- 1 x Aluminium head end pole (fold into 3)
- 1 x Peg pouch
- 8 x Ultra-lite tough aluminium pegs
- 1 x Emergency rain cover - see base pocket



### SETUP



Place Backpack Bed in a dry flat safe area - open top lid, loosen drawstring and rollout.

#### MAKE A-F-RAME

1. Secure 4 peg loops (A) with pegs.
2. Head end - thread pole tip through eyelet (B) and secure the 2 x built-in ropes (B) with pegs.
3. Foot end - position built-in foot pole to expose the foot window and use built-in rope (C) to peg down. Place peg into eyelet (D) to protect side zip from rain exposure.
4. For optimum setup, adjust tension between A-Frame pole ends. If required, adjust built-in rope lengths and pole tensions.



## MAKE A SHELTER

Open up side zip fully and tie built-in corner ropes to secure objects.

- TIP** Unused ropes can be moved to the eyelet for an extra tie up point.
- TIP** Make a Shelter during the day for shade.
- TIP** Unclip and open out mattress cover for easy cleaning.
- TIP** You can add or replace your own mattress.
- TIP** In very hot weather fully open the zip and sleep under the stars.



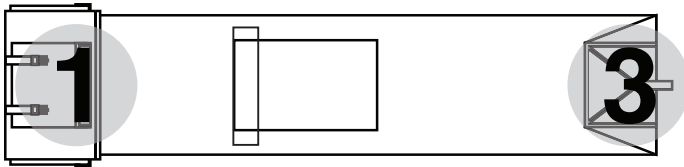
## WEATHER CONDITIONS



### WIND CLIPS

Use corner press studs on top fabric and attach to outer corner studs found on bag corners.

- TIP** Use Wind Clips to help protect bag from rain.



### RAIN - TWO ZONE OPEN

Behind head (1) and foot window (3) may be opened in A-Frame setup for 2 zone ventilation.

When walking in the rain use the Emergency Rain Cover for additional rain protection.

- TIP** Make A-Frame and ensure chest window (2) is zipped closed. Use velcro on the flap covering the top of the chest window (2) and ensure it is laying flat over the zip.

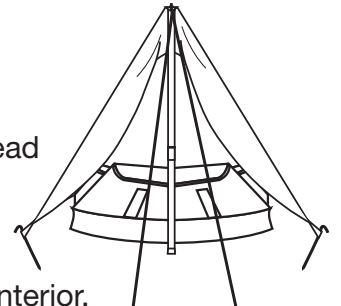


### HOT WEATHER - THREE ZONE OPEN

Open head (1), chest (2) and foot (3) windows for 3 zone ventilation.

### 4 SEASON - COLD WEATHER

Zip close the 4 season head end door (behind the backpack) to retain warmth and further protect the easy access interior.



## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Do not: machine wash, soak, bleach, tumble dry, iron, dry clean. Allow to dry thoroughly before storing. Store in a cool, dry place.

### LiteTrex® fabric

- Only clean lightly with soft sponge and water, dry in shade. Air regularly.
- Coated fabric - avoid surface abrasion and build up of dirt or fabric functions will deteriorate.

### ASI® Camp Mat

### Head pole & pegs

- Only clean with damp soft sponge and water, dry in shade.
- Wipe down after use with a sponge or towel as salt causes corrosion / dirt contributes to mildew growth.
- Be sure the shock cord in the head pole is dry before storing.
